1: Apologies for absence

2: Declarations of interest

Cllr Lane stated that the parish question had been asked at Southern Links meeting. It was stated that they knew they had problems but were not able to put them right. It is possible that there are communication problems between WDBC and Scania and also that Scania did not understand the road problems specific to such a rural area.

4: Reports from Outside Bodies

Cllr Lane has written to Simon Kitchen the DCC rep at the Southern Links regarding the TAP fund and the future of the parish lengthsman. There has been no reply to date.

Cllr Dodd queried what would happen if the parish had to take over the lengthsman job. Would DCC offload the problems and do they have the commitment to maintain the roads? It was noted that nationwide it would require over £500 million to take the road network to a reasonable standard.
