External auditor's limited assurance opinion 2024/25

On 23 September 2025, we issued a report detailing the results of our limited assurance review of Sections 1 and 2 of this authority's Annual Governance & Accountability Return for the year ended 31 March 2025. We explained that we were unable to certify completion of the review at that time. We are now in a position to certify completion of the review.

The external auditor report given in Section 3 of the Annual Governance & Accountability Return requires amendments as follows:

Except for the matters reported below, on the basis of our review of Sections 1 and 2 of the Annual Governance and Accountability Return (AGAR), in our opinion the information in Sections 1 and 2 of the AGAR is in accordance with Proper Practices and no other matters have come to our attention giving cause for concern that relevant legislation and regulatory requirements have not been met.

The smaller authority failed to approve the AGAR in time to publish it by 1 July 2025, the date required by the Accounts and Audit Regulations 2015, and did not disclose this by answering 'No' to Section 1, Box 1.

The smaller authority has disclosed that it made proper provision during the year 2024/25 for the exercise of public rights, by answering 'Yes' to Section 1, Assertion 4. However, as was reported last year, we are aware that it failed to do this and therefore should have answered 'No' to this Assertion. It has also disclosed that it took appropriate action on all matters raised in reports from internal and external audit, by answering 'Yes' to Section 1, Assertion 7, which, on the basis of the above is not correct.

The smaller authority has not addressed the 'except for' matters raised by the external auditor when qualifying the prior year annual return. The prior year Section 2 Boxes 3, 7 and 8 figures should have been restated to read £17,145, £30,721 and £30,721 respectively since the VAT debtor was incorrectly included on the bank reconciliation. Section 2, Box 1 for the current year is therefore incorrect and will require amending in the prior year comparatives when completing next year's AGAR.

The VAT debtor at the year end of £723 is incorrectly included on the bank reconciliation, Section 2 Boxes 3, 7 and 8 will require amending in the prior year comparatives when completing next year's AGAR.

Other matters not affecting our opinion which we draw to the attention of the authority:

We note that the smaller authority did not comply with Regulation 15 of the Accounts and Audit Regulations 2015 as it failed to make proper provision during the year 2025/26 for the exercise of public rights, since the period for the exercise of public rights, did not include the first 10 working days of July. As a result, the smaller authority must answer 'No' to Assertion 4 of the Annual Governance Statement for 2025/26 and ensure that it makes proper provision for the exercise of public rights during 2026/27. during 2026/27.

The smaller authority has not provided an adequate explanation for the variance between the prior and current year values in Box 2 of Section 2.
